Rio Brazos POA Membership Opinion Survey

Concurrent with our May membership meeting, we received your responses to our membership opinion survey. The following is a synopsis of your responses.

There were 31 surveys returned for a 17.6% response-rate, which is very good for a second survey. The demographic data allows us to determine that we had no responses from members on the West side off-river who live here part-time and no responses from the West side members who have lots only.

1. Regarding your opinion on the relative value of 6 different assets: swimming pool, boat launch, fishing pier, playground, picnic ground, community center all had high counts of excellent or good value of 86% or more. The lowest being the fishing pier and the highest being the pool, playground, park/picnic area and boat launch all at about 96%.

2. Regarding your usage of the 6 different assets:

3. Regarding your willingness to support an increase in the maintenance fee per year:

4. As to your opinion on the logjam cleanup job 92.3% agreed that they did an excellent/good job.

5. The effectiveness of signs at the West entrance to help remind you of a board meeting is 70.3% excellent/good.

6. According to your opinions on how well we kept the grass mowed, you agreed that we did an excellent/good job 82.1%.

7. We kept the pool clean and enjoyable 92.3% excellent/very good.

8. Should we replace the fishing pier, 72.4% "yes, absolutely" or "yes, not critical"

9. There were 23 responses to the most important issues, 18 responses to actions you want the board to take, and 20 responses to what the most important benefit.
12. 46.6% of respondents have visited the rio-brazos-poa.com website at least seldom. 53.3% has not but will and 1 respondent probably won't.

13. 65.5% of respondents have attended a board meeting, 20.7% have not, 10.3% have not but will in the future. One respondent does not want to be involved.
